Policy statement

At **Little Elms** we work with children, parents, external agencies and the community to ensure the welfare and safety of children and to give them the very best start in life. Children have the right to be treated with respect, be helped to thrive and to be safe from any abuse in whatever form.

We support the children within our care, protect them from maltreatment and have robust procedures in place to prevent the impairment of children's health and development. In our setting we strive to protect children from the risk of radicalisation and we promote acceptance and tolerance of other beliefs and cultures.

Safeguarding is a much wider subject than the elements covered within this single policy, therefore this document should be used in conjunction with the nursery's other policies and procedures listed in the Associated Documents.

What is Safeguarding?

Safeguarding is the action that is taken to promote the welfare of children and protect them from harm.

What does Safeguarding mean?

- Protecting children from abuse and maltreatment
- Preventing harm to children's health or development
- Ensuring children grow up with the provision of safe and effective care
- Taking action to enable all children and young people to have the best outcomes.
- Child protection is part of the safeguarding process. It focuses on protecting individual children identified
 as suffering or likely to suffer significant harm. This includes child protection procedures which detail how
 to respond to concerns about a child.

Little Elms has robust policies and procedures in place which aim to keep children safe, to protect them from harm and to ensure they have the best start in life.
